Travel with Metigoshe Ministries to Duluth, Minnesota. Duluth is a place like no other. An endless horizon where the largest freshwater lake in the world meets the sky. Enjoy the many “Metigoshe Special Additions” as you experience this “Adventure Anchored in Christ”.

GLENSHEEN MANSION

The historic Congdon Estate is a 20,000 square foot mansion operated by the University of Minnesota Duluth and sits on 12 acres of



waterfront property on Lake Superior. It has 30 rooms and was

constructed from 1905-1908. The home is a crowning example of design and craftsmanship of the Midwest in the early 20th century.

NORTH SHORE SCENIC RAILROAD FALL COLORS TRAIN RIDE

Enjoy the changing colors as you travel to the historic town of Two Harbors, where you will be free to tour, shop, eat and enjoy!



AERIAL LIFT BRIDGE

The Aerial Lift Bridge is a landmark in the port city of Duluth. The span began life in 1905 as the United States' first transporter bridge. In 1929-30, the span was converted to a vertical lift bridge and continues to operate today. It is 226' high and 501' long.



LUTSEN MOUNTAINS GONDOLA RIDE

View some of Cook County's most dramatic scenery on this gentle, aerial ride. From the Poplar River Valley and the rugged north shore of Lake Superior to the surrounding peaks of the Sawtooth Mountains, and the endless view of the colorful maple forest may be the main highlight of the entire week.



SPLIT ROCK LIGHTHOUSE TOUR

History comes to life as guides take you on a stroll through the historic site and tell the stories of the lighthouse keepers and their families in the early 1920s. See the giant lens up close and personal, hear the fog horn and dive into the history of Great Lakes shipping while experts answer your questions along the way. After the tour guide takes you to a lake overlook and to the lawn below the lighthouse, you will then be able to tour the site on your own and climb the lighthouse.



LAKE SUPERIOR TRAIN MUSEUM

Explore the impressive collection of historic railroad equipment that built Minnesota and our country. The museum is located in downtown Duluth, in the platforms at the yard of the original Historic Union Depot, built in 1892.

VISTA FLEET HARVEST DINNER CRUISE

Enjoy a relaxing dinner cruise with beautiful music and narrated highlights of the harbor. Take in never-ending views of Duluth's unique skyline and harbor activity. The tour features a delicious fall-themed dinner.



GREAT LAKES AQUARIUM

Built on the Duluth waterfront in 2000, the aquarium features animals and habitats found within the Great Lakes Basin as well as animals from other freshwater ecosystems, such as the Amazon River. It is also home to North America's largest sturgeon touch tank.
