What To Expect

Health Forms and Safety Precautions

Paper health forms are required for each child attending camp. A health form will be emailed to the grandparents or it can be found on our Forms and Info page on the website. Forms can be mailed in advance or brought to camp and turned in during registration. Online health forms are not available for Grandparent and Family Camp attendees. Adults and children both need to fill out the Pre-Camp Health Screening Form. Please bring the completed form with you to registration. If you have any pre-existing medical conditions, please seek advice from your physician for a recommendation whether you should attend camp. This is especially important for Grandparent campers over the age of 65 based on CDC recommendations.

Where Do I Go and Lodging Information



Registration for Grandparent and Family Camp begins at the front gate.

Registration for camp is at Pelican Lake and begins right at the front gate. Registration times are listed below for each of the camps. After registration and an introduction to camp, Laura Morken, Retreats Director, will hand out room assignments. Once you receive this information, you will go to either Gary's Place or the Christian Center and settle into your room.

A Note on Lodging

Beginning in 2020, requests for specific rooms, buildings or people will no longer be taken. Lodging will be based on the number of people in your group and matched with the appropriate size room we have available. This will make the most efficient use of our facility for all campers. Also, because of the full schedule at the retreat centers and the quick turn-around time for housekeeping, rooms will not be available for check-in until your camp introduction is over.

What to Bring

- Health form for each child
- Pre-Camp Health Screening Form for ALL people
- Cloth Face Covering/Mask
- Comfortable walking shoes
- Clothing for warm and cool weather
- Swimsuit and Towel
- Rain Poncho
- Bug Spray
- Sunscreen
- Bible
- Small backpack or bag for carting things from place to place



Money Matters

Remember to pay your balance due at least two weeks prior to the beginning of your camp session. Balances not paid prior to camp will have an additional **\$20.00 late charge** applied to the balance. ~~Any cancellation after May 31 or within 30 days of the registered camp session will forfeit the \$100 deposit.~~ (Suspended for 2020 Camp Season due to COVID-19 uncertainties.)

Adults registered for camp will receive all information for camp. When making payments, please indicate who the payment is for in the memo of your check.

There will be Metigoshe Bandannas available for purchase during check-in for \$5. These work great as a cloth face covering!




Directions to Camp Metigoshe

Directions From Hwy 5:

- Turn north onto Main Street in Bottineau (State Bank of Bottineau is on the corner)
- Go north approximately 9 miles
- At stop sign, turn right onto Hwy. 43
- Go east approximately 8.5 miles
- At the Camp Metigoshe Pelican Lake sign, turn right on the gravel road
- Drive 1 mile and turn left at Camp Metigoshe sign
- Drive 1.25 miles to the camp entrance on your left.

Directions Through Dunseith:

- Follow US 281 and ND 3 north about 10 miles to Hwy. 43
- Turn left onto Hwy. 43 and drive approximately 9 miles
- At Camp Metigoshe sign, turn left onto a gravel road
- Drive 1 mile--you will come to a dead end.
- Turn right and drive 1/2 mile to the camp entrance on your right
