## Day Camp In-Person Initial COVID-19 Policies

Camp Metigoshe is excited to come to your congregation for in-person “Day” Camp events in 2021. After consulting with guidelines set by the CDC and the American Camping Association, we feel the following basic protocols will keep both your community and our staff as safe as possible. This is a living document and may grow or change as new information is made available to us.

1. Day Camp Participants’ temperatures will be taken upon arrival either by a Camp Metigoshe staff member or a Host Congregation staff member/volunteer.
  - a. If the temperature is 100.4°F or above, they will be sent home.
2. Camp Metigoshe staff will be masked at all times, except while eating.
3. Day Camp Participants will be masked indoors at all times, while singing, and when distancing is not possible while outdoors.
4. As much of the event as possible -- if not all -- will take place outdoors.
5. Sanitization procedures are mirrored from Camp Metigoshe’s onsite policy: sanitize into an activity, sanitize all equipment used, and sanitize out of all activities. All volunteers, campers and staff will wash hands before meals.
6. Camp Metigoshe Staff will comply with any additional health and safety protocols established by the Host Congregation.
7. Metigoshe Ministries reserves the right to move to 100% online Day Camp if any unforeseen circumstances create an unsafe condition for staff or community members.
