## DAY CAMP TIMES

Day Camp runs from 9 am to 3 pm all days except Friday, 9 am to 11:30 am. Many congregations integrate a Day Camp celebration including a pot luck and program led by the campers. Some congregations choose to include a Thursday night lock-in experience for their older campers (those entering 4-6 grades).

## TRANSPORTATION

We will continue to cover the cost of mileage for travel to congregations within our constituency. If the congregation is outside our constituency, we will charge 58 cents per mile per car to transport the staff.

## DAY CAMP COST

The cost of day camp, regardless of the number of days a child attends, is \$45 per youth, \$35 for the second sibling, and \$35 for the third sibling. The maximum cost for a family is \$115 for the week.

The minimum total cost for a congregation for one week of day camp is \$600. (For example, if 10 youth attend at \$45/youth, a congregation is still responsible for the minimum \$600).

\* Early Session Special — May 26-29  
The cost of this day camp, regardless of the number of days a child attends, is \$40 per youth, \$30 for the second sibling, and \$30 for the third sibling. The maximum cost for a family is \$100 for the week.

The minimum cost for a congregation for this shorter week is \$525. (For example, if 10 youth attend at \$40/youth, a congregation is still responsible for the minimum \$525).
