Health Forms and Safety Precautions

All forms need to be completed at least 2 weeks prior to camp. Online forms will be turned off at that time in order to prepare them for the summer staff.

Forms Needed for Grandchildren: 2024 Grandchild Info Form, Disclaimer and Acknowledgement Form, and Health History and Medical for Campers Form.

Where Do I Go and Lodging Information



Registration for Grandparent and Family Camp begins at the front gate.

Registration for camp is at Pelican Lake and begins right at the front gate. Registration times are listed below for each of the camps. Room assignments will be handed out by our retreat director or host when you arrive after dinner. Once you receive this information, you will go to your room assignment and settle into your room.

A Note on Lodging

Lodging will be based on the number of people in your group and matched with the appropriate size room we have available. This will make the most efficient use of our facility for all campers.

Communication Prior to Camp

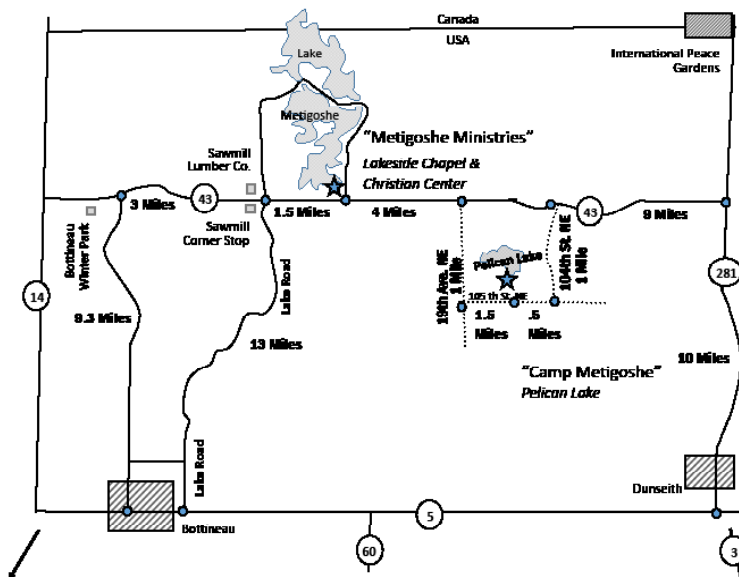
All communications prior to camp will be through email and text message. Please make sure to have an active email and cell phone number in your account.

Money Matters

Remember to pay your balance due at least two weeks prior to the beginning of your camp session. If sending a check, please indicate in the memo who the payment should be applied to.

If there is a balance due one week prior to camp, the credit card on file will be run for the balance. Balances not paid prior to camp will have an additional **\$20.00 late charge** applied to the balance.

Any cancellation after May 31 or within 30 days of the registered camp session will forfeit the \$50 deposit.



Directions to Camp Metigoshe

Directions From Hwy 5:

- Turn north onto Main Street in Bottineau (State Bank of Bottineau is on the corner)
- Go north approximately 9 miles
- At stop sign, turn right onto Hwy. 43
- Go east approximately 8.5 miles
- At the Camp Metigoshe Pelican Lake sign, turn right on the gravel road
- Drive 1 mile and turn left at Camp Metigoshe sign
- Drive 1.25 miles to the camp entrance on your left.

Directions Through Dunseith:

- Follow US 281 and ND 3 north about 10 miles to Hwy. 43
- Turn left onto Hwy. 43 and drive approximately 9 miles
- At Camp Metigoshe sign, turn left onto a gravel road
- Drive 1 mile--you will come to a dead end.
- Turn right and drive 1/2 mile to the camp entrance on your right
