

Outdoor Ministry Program Intern Job Description

Accountable to the Program Director

Overview:

- A year-long [September 5, 2023 – August 12, 2024] internship opportunity that brings out the intern's strengths while providing educational and experiential learning environments. The Program Intern will gain a deeper understanding of year-long outdoor ministry, and develop as a faithful leader in ministry for Metigoshe Ministries, and the church at large.

- Continuing education opportunities [to be selected with supervisor]
- 1 Week Paid Vacation
- 10 paid holidays per year (see Staff Handbook for details)
- 10 sick days

Qualifications:

- At least one year of post-high school experience
- Steward heart, willing to do a variety of tasks
- Christian, with an eagerness to share and grow in faith
- Basic understanding of ELCA worldview/ theology
- Camping and/or retreating experience preferred
- Current driver's license
- Musical ability [preferred, but not required]

Internship Responsibilities Include:

- Assist in the planning, organizing, and leading of Metigoshe in Motion events.
- Create an atmosphere of trust and sharing to build relationships in MIM and constituent congregations.
- Assist in the leadership of summer camp and retreating ministry at Metigoshe Ministries.
- Assist in office tasks as needed.
- Understand and project compliance with the American Camping Association [ACA], State of North Dakota, and Metigoshe Ministries policies, standards and procedures.
- Welcome all retreat guests, summer campers, and MIM participants with Christian hospitality, grace and peace.
- Other tasks based on gifts, abilities and interest, and the needs of the ministry to be discussed with supervisor.
