This horse and buggy narrated tour rambles along at a relaxing pace. Sites visited will be Arch Rock, Fort Mackinac, and other great island sights.

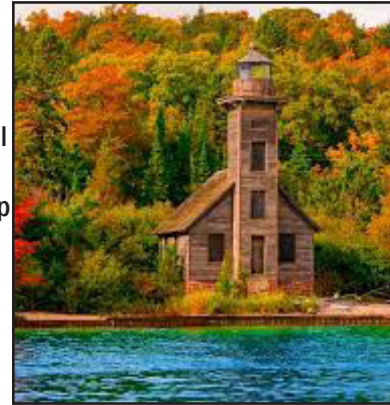


### Soo Locks Cruise, Sault Ste. Marie

Much like the Great Lakes themselves, the Soo Locks are vital to Sault Ste. Marie’s tourism industry. The Soo Locks sit at the northern end of the St. Marys River connecting Lake Superior and Lake Huron. The Locks make it possible for boats, of all sizes, to traverse the 21-foot difference between the upper river and the lower river better known as the St. Marys Rapids. Locking through is your opportunity to actually experience the tour boat raising, or lowering, with 22 million gallons of water fed by gravity (no pumps) into the Poe Lock. With a bit of luck, you’ll be able to pass by a freighter and get a full understanding of their incredible size and powerful presence on the river.

### Pictured Rocks Cruise, Munising, MI

Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore hugs the south shore of Lake Superior in Michigan’s Upper Peninsula. It’s known for the dramatic multicolored Pictured Rocks cliffs. Unusual sandstone formations like Miners Castle and Chapel Rock define the park’s headlands. Remnants of shipwrecks dot the shoreline around Au Sable Point’s 19th-century lighthouse. The Pictured Rock cruise will highlight East Channel Lighthouse, Grand Island, Miners Castle, the Painted Coves, Caves of All Colors, Lovers’ Leap, Rainbow Cave, Indian Head, Gull Rookery, Grand Portal, Battleship Rocks, Flower Vase, Indian Drum, Chapel Cove, Chapel Rock and Spray Falls.



### Young Frankenstein Production

#### NorShor Historical Theater, Duluth, MN

The NorShor Theatre is an entertainment venue in downtown Duluth, Minnesota, and was formerly a movie palace and Opera House. It occupies a prominent place along Superior Street, and underwent



a massive renovation effort by the City of Duluth. The NorShor played a significant role in the artistic history of

Duluth, and is generally considered a landmark. Mel Brooks’ “Young Frankenstein” will be the production we will attend at the historic theater.
